Students to download the play Woyzeck from the following link:

Read the play through twice, then write an answer to these questions:

In your informed opinion (based on some research):

- What is the play about (key themes and synopsis), and how might it be relevant to a modern audience watching a production of it today?
- What considerations would a director and set designer need to make if putting on a version of Woyzeck? (Think about the structure of the play, potential scene transitions and style of the piece when answering)
- If you were putting on a production of Woyzeck, how might you stage it? – think about venue, set, costume, light and sound, acting style. Draw a potential set design.

Use research to inform you but everything you write must be in your own words and any quotes must be clearly marked. Remember to write down where you got your information from. You can be as creative as you like with your own staging, as if you have as much money as you please.

NOTE:

It is okay to go to Wikipedia for information initially, but you should find other reliable sources to quote from for task B and not quote from Wikipedia.
