We use a package called Fusion 360 a lot in A level Product Design. It is superb 3D modelling software that works with the 3D printer and it's free for 3 years to you as an educational license. We have found that a useful way to login is as a personal "hobbyist". This gives you free access.

If you can't get the license to work you can still use it for free as a 30 day trial and we can then sort you out with an educational license when you start the course in September.

Once you have downloaded the software you can begin to use it by setting up an Autodesk account. You can use your school email as a username and it requires a mobile phone number as it texts you a login code every time you login. The software saves in the cloud so all your designs will be saved on line which means you can start work at home and continue them in school.
