How the day will work:

- All students will be off timetable for the day unless they are due to be T3 or they are currently excluded from PE lessons. Time in T3 must be completed before students are able to join the rest of the school in the festival of sport.
- All students will be required to come to school in their school PE kit with a plain coloured t-shirt representing the colour of their house:

Faith to wear blue

Justice to wear red

Mission to wear yellow

Service to wear green

Please make sure you are wearing only the following with your house coloured t-shirt:

- School PE skorts
- School PE shorts
- Plain black leggings (No logos)
- White socks and trainers.

How the day will work:

- All students will arrive at school and go to tutor period to be registered.
- At the end of tutor period (9am) tutors must take their tutees to their first event area.
- This event will last the duration of period 1.
- Tutors must take their tutees to their second event area.
- This event will last the duration of period 2.
- There will be a shortened break for students and staff to get food and drink, use the toilet and refill water bottles.
- At the end of break tutors must take their tutees to their third event area for the duration of period 3 and again to their fourth event area for the duration of period 4.
- There will be a shortened lunch break for staff and students to get food and drink, use the toilet and refill water bottles.
- At the end of the lunch break tutors will need to meet with their tutees in their designated area on the bottom field to be registered.
- The afternoon activities will all take place on the bottom field and will be completed in time for the buses at 3.20pm.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER AND FAQ's:

- Any variations on our school PE kit will unfortunately mean that you will not be allowed to participate in the day – this includes **NOT** wearing jewellery please.
- Although the use of face paints is a lovely idea we have too many students in school with potential allergies to some chemicals used in face paints so these will not be allowed to be used.
- You **MUST** bring a water bottle BUT water is to be drunk and NOT thrown.
- You **MUST** bring a hat and sun cream if the weather is sunny and hot.
- Any time in T3 must be fulfilled and students not entering into the day in the right way will be taken to T3 for the remainder of the day.
- You **MUST** wear a **t-shirt** (not a crop top please) representing your house colour.
- The canteen will be open as usual at both break and lunch.
- You must stay with your year group and tutor group and make sure that you are in the right place at the right time.
- Toilet access will be restricted to break and lunch times for the day other than for emergencies.
- Please do not leave any litter at your events – take it with you and use the bins please.
- We will have a first aid tent on the field for injuries/illness so please **DO NOT** go to the hub.
- It is your tutor groups responsibility with your tutor to complete your team sheet and ensure that everybody is taking part in something.
