Stud	ents should:
	Be aged from 13-17 years. (Depending upon student numbers involved students may be in one group or allocated into levels: 13-14 years old (Beginner), 14-15 years old (Intermediate) or 15-17 years old (Advanced))
	Be interested in cyber security as a career
	Be able to use apps and a computer to access on-line content
	Ideally be able to bring their own laptop/tablet, with Wi-Fi, for use during the Camp (please let us know if you don't have your own laptop/tablet to use during camp)
	Have an Autism Spectrum Condition diagnosis or to be actively seeking a diagnosis
	Be willing to disclose their diagnosis to JP Morgan and National Autistic Society staff and supervisors and to be comfortable with the National Autistic Society sharing a brief autism profile about themselves during the delivery of autism awareness training/coaching for JP Morgan and additional National Autistic Society staff, on you behalf, prior to the Cybercamp. (N.B. autism profiling will be completed beforehand with students and their Parents/Guardians - guided by the National Autistic Society. A profile will be completed to identify any autism and sensory difficulties/challenges and other neurodiversities/conditions, so reasonable adjustments can be put in place when attending the Cybercamp.)
	Be personally motivated and well enough to commit to participating in:
	 a 1 week-long, non-residential Cybercamp (beginners/intermediate/advanced aggroups), Autumn 24-28 October 2022 (Half Term school holiday)
	Have the ability to travel independently or with existing support on a daily basis arriving for a 9.30am start and leaving when finished at 3.30pm, to and from the JI Morgan campus, Bournemouth, Chaseside site.
	Have internet, email and telephone or Skype access and be responsive to requests fo information and queries from the National Autistic Society or JP Morgan staff
	Be able to access group training (possibly up to 20 people in a group)
